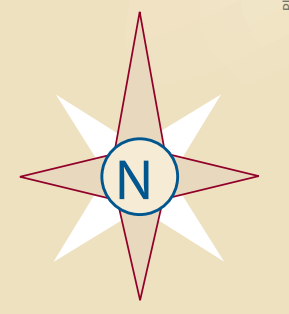


# Yakima Valley Map
