



STAY IN THE GAP...UNION GAP!

Founded more than a century ago, Union Gap is an old city with a contemporary attitude. Nestled in the Yakima Valley, in the “gap” where two mountain heads meet, the community has retained the best elements of its history and layered them with modern conveniences and attractions like shops, restaurants, parks and festivals.

Yakima Valley’s only indoor shopping mall is located in Union Gap, at the north end of town on Valley Mall Boulevard. Stretching more than 746,000 square feet, Valley Mall is home to more than 90 specialty stores, merchants and restaurants, and anchored by popular department stores Macy’s and Sears.

There’s a favorite store for everyone in the family, from Motherhood Maternity to American Eagle Outfitters to Hot Topic. You’ll also find high-quality jewelry at stores like Kay Jewelers and Zales Jewelers, electronics at Radio Shack, athletic shoes and apparel at Finish Line and Foot Locker, and treats along the way at Cold Stone Creamery and Orange Julius.

Adjacent to the Valley Mall is Valley Mall Plaza, a collection of stores and eateries that includes Borders Books, Eddie Bauer, Famous Footwear, Old Navy, TJ Maxx, Mongolian Grill and many more. There’s ample free parking at both shopping centers, making a shopping trip convenient any time of day.

One of Union Gap’s most distinctive and entertaining attractions is the Central Washington Agricultural Museum, which is located in sprawling Fullbright Park at the south end of town. The museum is a wonderland of

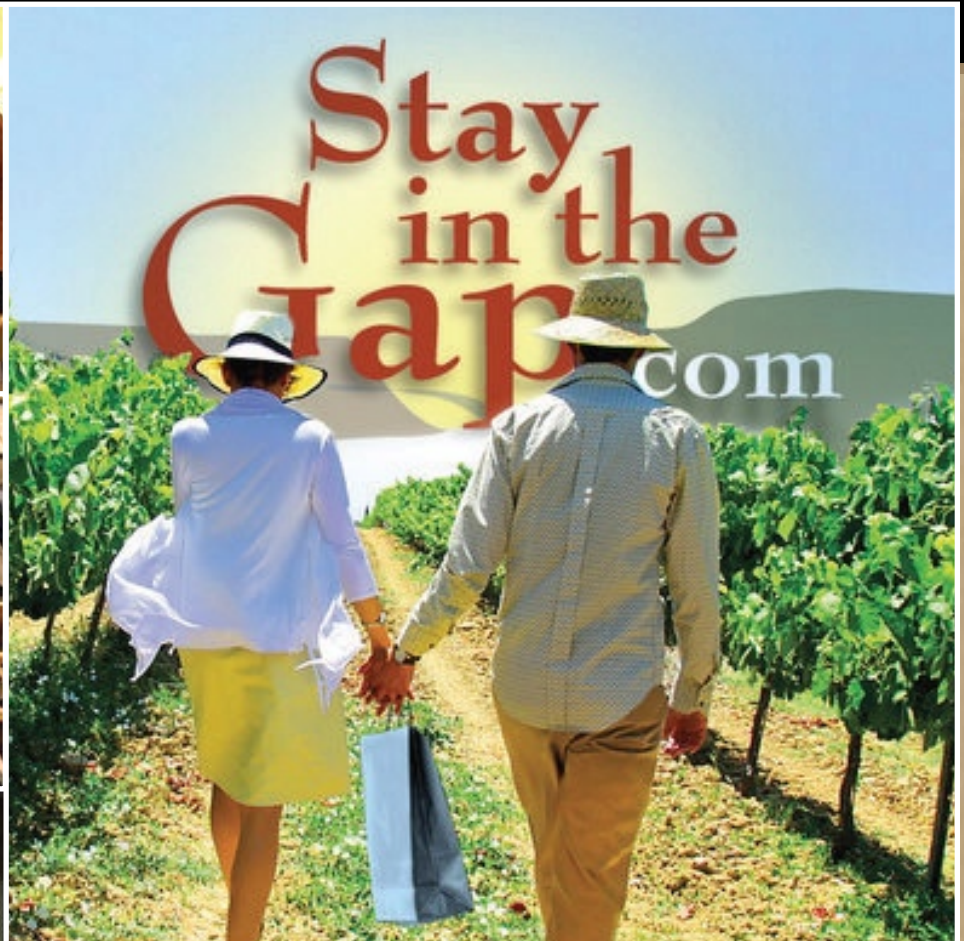
farm history and includes a room with more than 3,000 antique hand tools, steam engines, a working saw mill and multiple generations of tractors, harvesters and other farm machines.

Fullbright Park itself is a popular destination for families, dog owners and events. There’s a large playground for kids, a dog area where pooches can fetch and roam, and big grassy fields where antique truck buffs can gather for the annual Antique Truck show every May.

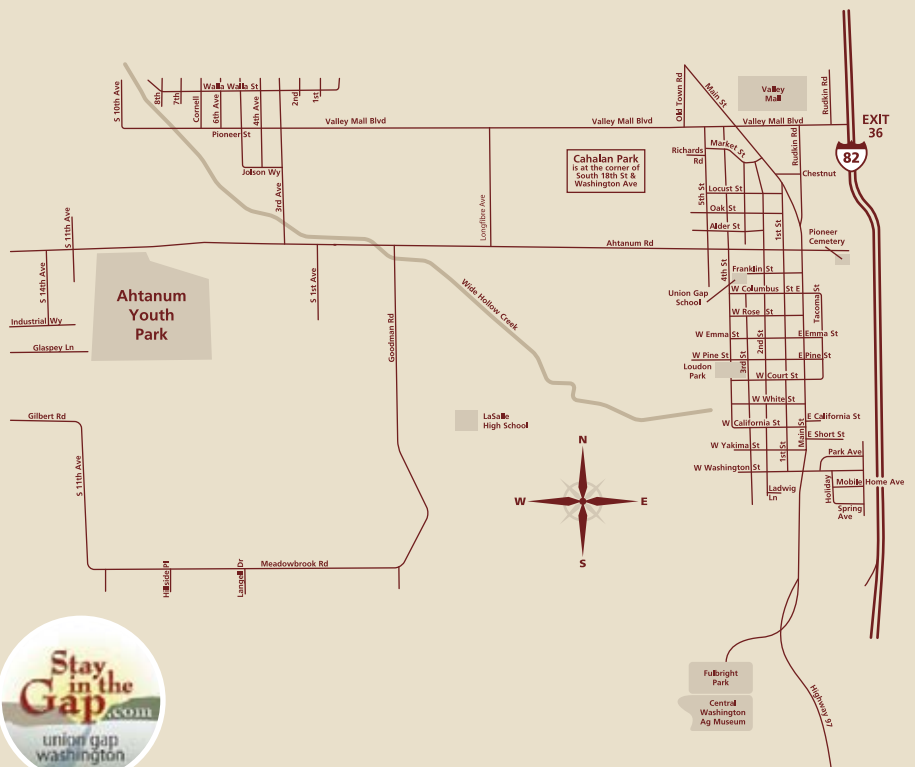
Fun annual festivals allow residents and visitors to dip their toes in Union Gap’s rich history. Old Town Days, which includes a parade, a sports car rally and an “American Idol”-style singing competition, takes place in June, while the Central Washington Antique Farm Exposition is held in August.

See a huge collection of antique farm implements and watch demonstrations of binding, thrashing, flour grinding and bread baking. But why just be a spectator? You can participate by adding your weight to the antique tractor-pulling contest. Be sure to browse the huge flea market for treasured collectibles.
