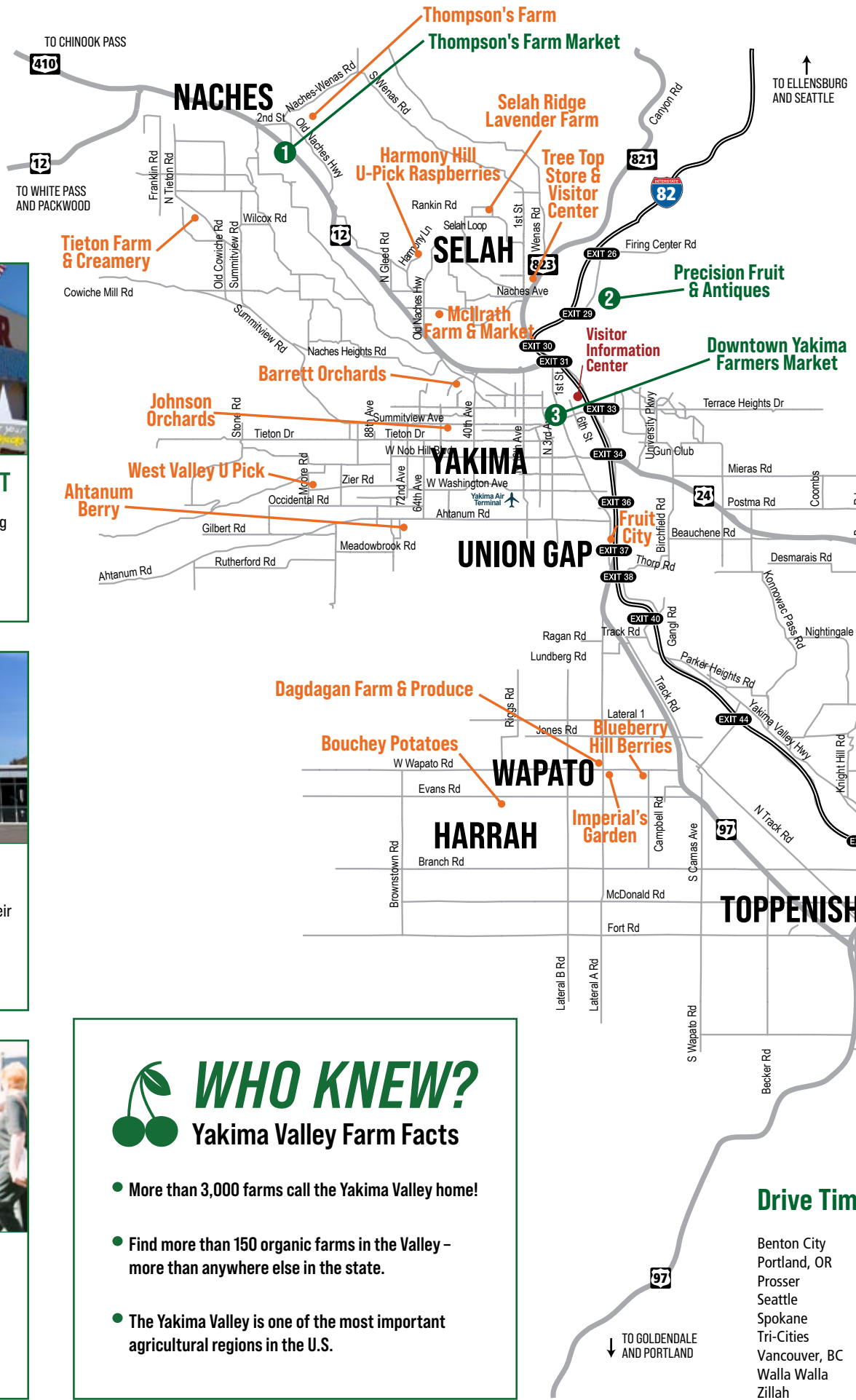
1. THOMPSON'S FARM & FARM MARKET

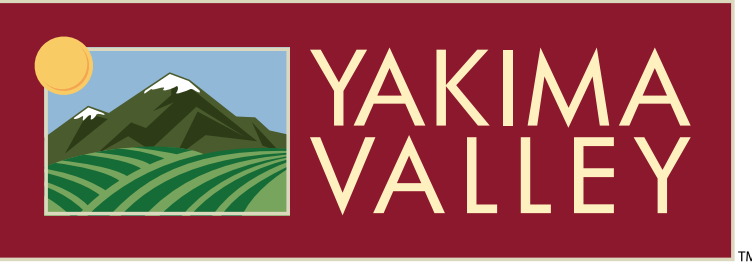
